CASE: EF EDUCATION FIRST

EF Education First (www.ef-danmark.dk) is a world leading organization specialized in language travels and cultural exchange, offering nine languages on 50 destinations around the world. EF offers four different programs: Language travel, Language course, Academic year abroad and High school exchange year.

STUDYING ABROAD

High school exchange year (www.ef-danmark.dk/highschool/) is relevant for students aged 14 to 18 who seek a semester or a whole year of academic exchange to either the United States, United Kingdom or Ireland. Students will be living with a host family as well as studying at a local high school. This program gives Danish students the opportunity to become part of the local community and make new friends while they experience the unique high school feeling.

1. A LETTER TO YOUR HOST FAMILY (MINIMUM 100 WORDS)

Imagine that you are going to be an exchange student in Texas, USA, after your summer holiday. Before your exchange year begins, you write a letter to your host family, so they can get to know you.

Your letter includes (in random order):

- Information about yourself (name, age, interests, school, family)
- Why have you chosen to be an exchange student in the USA?
- How can you contribute to your host family?
- Which parts of the Danish culture will you bring with you to Texas?
- What do you expect from your stay; including living at a host family and studying at a high school in the USA?

Begin your letter with "Dear host family" and end with "Best regards".

The letter must contain at least 100 words.
